## DAY 1

### ARRIVAL DAY

## DAY 3

Today you would have another chance to see the sights of the city which could include the Tower of London which has been used as a royal palace, prison and site of execution which included members of our royal family. Today, you are able to have a look around the tower, have a photo with a Beefeater and see the stunning Crown Jewels. From The Tower it is just a short walk to the Tower Bridge Experience where you are able to explore the history of the bridge as well as visit the London Tombs for a terrifying encounter with the un-dead. In the afternoon you could visit HMS Belfast, a floating museum which is moored on the banks of the River Thames.

Today you could visit some of the magnificent museums that London has to offer including the National Portrait Gallery which is home to one of the largest collections of portraits in the world, the National Gallery which has a collection of some of the most beautiful paintings in
